Dan Hutchins and Sue Nickerson of Kent County Public Schools discussed the internship program. In Fall 2019 Kent County Public Schools receive a MSDE grant for 24 students to work up to 96 hours after school in a paid working experience. KCPS wants employers to know about the program. Goals are to get kids job ready, to learn about employers in our County and to decide what they want to do after high school. A new grant is being applied for, for students to work up to 180 hours.
